Ambient air pollution was responsible for 45 lakh deaths, and hazardous chemical pollutants for with lakh deaths 17 lakh, 9 attributable to lead pollution.

- According to the report, air pollution is most severe in the Indo-Gangetic Plain. This area contains New Delhi and many of the most polluted cities. Burning of biomass in households was the single largest cause of air pollution deaths in India, followed by coal combustion and crop burning.

 - The lead effects most likely to be encountered in current populations are neurological effects in children. Infants and young children are especially sensitive to lead exposures, which may contribute to behavioral problems, learning deficits and lowered IQ.
 - Lead is persistent in the environment and can be added to soils and sediments through deposition from sources of lead air pollution. Other sources of lead to ecosystems include direct discharge of waste streams to water bodies and mining. Elevated lead in the environment can result in decreased growth and reproduction in plants and animals, and neurological effects in vertebrates.

 - In 1978, the U.S. began using a more detailed producer price index (PPI) in place of wholesales price indexes (WPIs).

end of a year. The percentage increase in WPI over a year gives the rate of inflation for that year.
